# SERMON NOTES March 9th, 2014

### **Covenant of Community**

14:1 That night all the members of the community raised their voices and wept aloud. <sup>2</sup> All the Israelites grumbled against Moses and Aaron, and the whole assembly said to them, "If only we had died in Egypt! Or in this wilderness! <sup>3</sup> Why is the Lord bringing us to this land only to let us fall by the sword? Our wives and children will be taken as plunder. Wouldn't it be better for us to go back to Egypt?" 4 And they said to each other, "We should choose a leader and go back to Egypt."

<sup>13</sup> Moses said to the Lord, "Then the Egyptians will hear about it! By your power you brought these people up from among them. <sup>14</sup> And they will tell the inhabitants of this land about it. They have already heard that you, Lord, are with these people and that you, Lord, have been seen face to face, that your cloud stays over them, and that you go before them in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. <sup>15</sup> If you put all these people to death, leaving none alive, the nations who have heard this report about you will say, <sup>16</sup> 'The Lord was not able to bring these people into the land he promised them on oath, so he slaughtered them in the wilderness.' (*Numbers 14:1-4,13-16, NIV*)
